The Sorrowful Mysteries (Tuesday, Fridays and Sundays of Septuagesima & Lent)

The Glorious Mysteries (Wednesday, Saturday and Sundays of Eastertide & Time After Pentecost)

The Third Person of the Blessed Trinity is addressed as the Holy Ghost.
